December 21, 2021

Lori Redwine stated that items IX and X would flip in order of discussion on the regular agenda. Jon Mooneyham was not able to attend the meeting, there will be no parent comments this evening.

A motion was made by Travis Ross to approve the regular agenda. The motion was approved with unanimous consent.

Consent Agenda was presented:

- A. Approve the minutes of the previous meeting
- B. Approve the financial statements, monthly bills, transfer of funds.
- C. Program Evaluations- Operation of Plant
- D. Misc. Contracts- Navitas Contract, Gillis Contract

Dr. Meyers presented to the Board the 2022-2023 Draft School Calendar. The calendar would have 170 Days of student contact, 179- Teacher contract days, and a full week of Spring break. The late starts would be moved to the 2nd Wednesday of each month. The last day of school is scheduled for May 19th but would not go past May 26th if snow days were required.

The motion was made by David Adamczyk to approve the Calendar for the 2022-2023 school year. With a unanimous vote of 6-yes and –no the motion was approved.

Dr. Meyers presented to the board Sidewalk Consideration for the area from Country Club to Eklund. Dr. Meyers explained the importance of adding a sidewalk to the area from Country Club to Eklund to make it safer for students walking to and from school. A meeting with the city would be required to discuss options for this improvement.

Dr. Suzanne Brennaman presented to the Board the updated Return to learn plan. The plan will now read when buildings reach 10 % of their students are in isolation due to positive tests or symptoms after exposure that specific building will be required to wear masks. The District will no longer be quarantining students due to exposure. If a student is exposed and begins to develop symptoms or tests positive for Covid, per CDC guidelines that student will be in isolation for 10 days.

Dr. Meyers presented to the Board financial information for the \$10 Million bond that will be voted on in the April election. Dr. Meyers gave an explanation of Bonding Capacity for the District and an explanation of no tax increase bond information. Dr. Meyers shared that Pleasant Hill has the lowest levy in the county.
