## 2021-2022 Preliminary School Calendar

Superintendent, Dr. Steven Meyers presented a draft of the 2021-2022 School Year Calendar to the Board for their consideration to be voted on in January.

## Leave Resolution extending COVID leave

Superintendent, Dr. Steven Meyers presented to the Board proposed updates to COVID leave procedures, extending personal leave for confirmed positive cases and caring for family members who have tested positive as well.

The Resolution includes:

- Does not apply to all the types of absences that an employee could use under the EPSL and does not include the Emergency Family and Medical Leave, which also expires on Dec. 31
- Does not cover absences
  - To Care for a child whose school or daycare is closed
  - For persons who are particularly vulnerable to the virus, but who have not been exposed; and
  - Due to illness "substantially similar" to COVID-19
- Only applies to employees who are caring for their spouse, child or parent that is diagnosed with COVID-19, as defined under the Family and Medical Leave Act (FMLA).
- Excludes substitute employees
- Allows the district to require more documentation of the absence than was allowed under Federal Law.
- Allows for the Superintendent or designee to deny the use of leave in circumstances where employees are not following district protocol or are violating an isolation order or recommendation or other local, state or federal health order.

# Board approved raises for Substitute Pay

Dr. Steven Meyers presented to the Board proposed raises to the District's Sub Pay Scale. Regular subs would earn \$105 per day and long term subs will earn \$145 per day.

# John T. Belcher Scholarship

High School Senior, Landon Fatino was approved to represent the Pleasant Hill School District for the John T. Belcher Scholarship. This scholarship is from MSBA through the Future Builders Foundation.
