

## Non-A+ Colleges/Universities Offering A+ Incentives

*Last updated September 2016*

PLEASE NOTE: The list of benefits below are NOT exhaustive NOR are they regularly updated and therefore may/may not be accurate at the time this document is being accessed. Check with the admissions office of the college/university to ask directly if their institution offers scholarships/stipends for students with A+ student certification.

<b>Avila University</b>	<b>Yes!</b> \$1,000 scholarship, renewable all 4 years, in addition to any other academic scholarship the student qualifies for.
<b>Central Methodist University</b>	No
<b>College of the Ozarks</b>	No
<b>Culver-Stockton College</b>	<b>Yes!</b> \$1,500 A+ academic scholarship. Can't be combined with a talent scholarship (example: athletics or fine arts).
<b>Drury University</b>	<b>Yes!</b> If a member Phi Theta Kappa honor society (from a 2 year community college), student can earn a \$1,000 transfer student scholarship per year. Renewable.
<b>Fontbonne University</b>	<b>Yes!</b> \$1,000 plus student can add any merit based scholarships. Complete A+ form online by Mar 1.
<b>Kansas City Art Institute</b>	<b>Yes!</b> Offers \$1,000 per year. Renewable each year.
<b>Missouri Baptist University</b>	No, but they take the A+ eligibility into consideration when awarding university scholarships.
<b>Missouri Southern State University</b>	<b>Yes!</b> \$500 per semester for a max of 8 consecutive semesters. Can be added with other scholarships. Application required online.
<b>Missouri State University</b>	<b>Yes!</b> <u>Westplains Campus only</u> - Full A+ benefits. <u>Springfield Campus</u> - \$500 per year. Limited number. Download application online. Renewable with a 3.25 Missouri State GPA and 27 credit hours per year.
<b>Missouri University of Science and Technology</b>	No
<b>Missouri Valley College</b>	<b>Yes!</b> Half tuition. Can't be stacked with other scholarships.
<b>Missouri Western</b>	<b>Yes!</b> This competitive \$1,500 scholarship is awarded to students who enroll in a four-year degree program and who have a 3.0 high school GPA. It is renewable for 3 years with a 3.25 postsecondary GPA.
<b>Northwest Missouri State</b>	<b>Yes!</b> \$1,500, renewable for an additional year if you meet the criteria. Limited number available. May be combined with other Northwest scholarships. Student must have an ACT score of 21 or higher along with the A+ graduate requirements.
<b>Park University</b>	<b>Yes!</b> A+ graduates can receive \$3,000 per year if they have a 3.25 GPA in

	high school OR 21 on the ACT. This can be combined with outside scholarships or a sports scholarship from Park University. Student must submit a letter from the HS A+ Office stating that the student will graduate with A+ certification. This scholarship is renewable.
<b>Rockhurst University</b>	No, but transfer scholarships are available.
<b>Saint Louis University</b>	No, but transfer scholarships are available.
<b>Southeast Missouri State</b>	<b>Yes!</b> The Southeast A+ Scholarship is authorized to cover tuition and general fees for courses that are part of an eligible program: Associate of Applied Science Degree in Computer Technology (options in automated Manufacturing, Microcomputer Systems and Technical Computer Graphics) or the Associate of Arts degree in Child Care and Guidance.
<b>Southwest Baptist University</b>	No
<b>Stephens College</b>	<b>Yes!</b> \$1,000 per year. Can be combined with additional scholarships.
<b>Truman State University</b>	<b>Yes!</b> \$500 per year for A+ eligible students for 4 semesters. Must have 3.0 or higher GPA
<b>University of Central Missouri</b>	No
<b>University of Missouri-Columbia</b>	No
<b>University of Missouri- Kansas City</b>	<b>Yes!</b> This competitive A+Scholarship is worth \$1,500. It is renewable for 4 years. Deadline is Mar 1.
<b>University of Missouri- St. Louis</b>	No
<b>Webster University</b>	<b>Yes!</b> \$1,000 per year for A+ eligible students with an ACT of 21 or higher (for housing). Can be used with other scholarships. Deadline is Feb 1.
<b>Westminster University</b>	No, but they do take A+ eligibility into consideration when awarding university scholarships.
<b>William Jewell University</b>	No, but they do offer \$1,000 to students transferring to William Jewell who previously received A+ funds at a community college. The scholarship is offered in addition to other transfer awards but not applicable to students receiving additional Jewell awards (i.e. athletic scholarships or talent scholarships, etc.)
<b>William Woods University</b>	<b>Yes!</b> \$1,000 a year, renewable. Can be combined with other scholarships.
