

Non-A+ Colleges/Universities Offering A+ Incentives (Last Update December 2021)

PLEASE NOTE: The list of benefits below are NOT exhaustive NOR are they regularly updated and therefore may/may not be accurate at the time this document is being accessed. Check with the admissions office of the college/university to ask directly if their institution offers scholarships/stipends for students with A+ student certification.

Avila University	Yes! \$500 scholarship- 1st year. Potential for renewal each year.
Culver-Stockton College	Yes! May receive renewable \$1500 scholarship for 4 years, based upon eligibility criteria
Drury University	Yes! May receive Honors Scholarship (amounts vary) only if attending evening and online classes <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Available to students who have a 3.0 cumulative GPA and are full-time enrolled • Available to students for their first 60 hours of credit, resident or transfer work • Honors Scholarship will not exceed \$60 per credit hour • Scholarships are non-renewable, but students may re-apply
Evangel University	Yes! \$1,000 scholarship for first-time Freshmen and transfers who are completing or have completed the Missouri A+ Schools Program. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Renewable with 2.0 GPA
Fontbonne University	Yes! May be eligible for \$1,000 per year in additional scholarship funds.
Hannibal-LaGrange	Yes! Offers a \$3,000 scholarship; non-stackable <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Renewable with a 2.5 cumulative GPA.
Kansas City Art Institute	Yes! Offers \$1 ,000 per year; renewable for four years.
Merrell University of Beauty Arts	Non-Renewable \$1,000 to full-time for First Year Students. Applied after completion of course.
Missouri Baptist University	Yes! \$1,000 per year, eligible for renewal for 4 years.
Missouri Southern State University	Yes! A+ Leadership Scholarship. Total of \$1,000 per year; \$500 per semester for a max of 8 semesters; stack-able <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Application required • Must enroll in at least 12 credit hours per semester • Must be entering MSSU first semester immediately following high school • Maintain 2.5 GPA for renewal.
Missouri State University	Yes! Limited number of \$500 scholarships; non-stackable <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Must apply by June 1 after senior year of high school/before freshman year of college • Renewable for 4 years for students with 3.25 GPA and completion of 27 credit hours
Missouri Western	Yes! A+ scholarship of at least \$500 per year, with additional scholarship amounts earned based on performance on the ACT/SAT (up to \$850 A+ scholarship dollars per academic year). The A+ Scholarship renews and grows each year as long as students remain enrolled full time with a minimum GPA of 2.0. Students who earn the A+ certified stamp on their transcript are also eligible for Missouri Western's Griffon Guarantee Scholarship.
Northwest Missouri State	Yes! Northwest A+ Scholarship \$1,500, only available to first-time freshman beginning in the fall semester. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Limited number awarded • Score ACT 18-36 and have minimum 2.50 high school GPA • Apply for admissions by April 1 • Renewable for one year by completing 24 credit hours at Northwest during the year with a 3.30 Northwest cumulative GPA
Ozark Christian College	Yes! Ambassador Scholarship for Missouri A+ Scholarship, \$2000 for a max of 8 semesters <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Stackable with Premier or Merit-Based Scholarships • Can be combined with other academic institutional scholarships and performance. Must enroll within two academic years of award date. • Renewable if student maintains full-time enrolled status at GPA of 2.5.
Park University	Yes! \$5 ,000 scholarship annually, Parkville only <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Letter of eligibility from high school counselor required • 3.25 or higher cumulative GPA • Renewable for 4 years with 3.0 GPA and full-time student status. • Number of awards varies

Rockhurst University	<p>NO but transfer scholarships are available based on academic merit:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • If student transfers in and were a member of Phi Theta Kappa before entering Rockhurst, they could be eligible for a \$24,000 scholarship, renewable with 3.3 GPA; • If they transfer in with a 3.6 GPA or higher, student could be eligible for a \$19,500, renewable with 3.3 GPA cumulative; • If student transfers in with a 3.0-3.59 GPA; could be eligible for \$15,400 scholarship, renewable with 3.0 GPA • If student transfers in with a 2.6-2.99 GPA; could be eligible for \$11,300 scholarship, renewable with 3.0 GPA. • Scholarships are not pulled but reduced 10% if GPA goes below minimum requirement
Southeast Missouri State	<p>Yes! The Southeast A+ Scholarship will cover tuition and general fees for courses that are part of an eligible Associates Degree program.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • High school graduate residing in Cape Girardeau, Bollinger, Butler, Dunklin, Mississippi, New Madrid, Pemiscot, Ripley, Scott, Stoddard, and Wayne county • Submit a final high school transcript with the A+ Seal • Enroll as a full-time, degree-seeking student at a Southeast Regional Campus in Kennett or Sikeston • May not be combined with any other Southeast Academic scholarship • If any federal/state need-based grants and/or other awards specifically denoted for tuition/general fees are received, the value of the A+ Scholarship will be reduced by the same dollar amount. • Renewable each year with 2.5 GPA and 12 semester credit hours
Truman State University	<p>Yes! \$500 per year for A+ eligible students. This is a Truman funded scholarship for completion of the MO A+ program. Official verification required on final HS transcript.</p>
Webster University	<p>Yes! A+ Scholarship, \$1,000; renewable each year</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Awarded to first-time freshmen who have completed the requirements for the A+ Program. • Deadline is Feb. 1 of senior year.
Westminster College	<p>NO but they do take A+ eligibility in to consideration when awarding university scholarships.</p>
William Woods University	<p>Yes! \$1 ,000 a year, renewable each year. Can be combined with other scholarships.</p>
